

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-76

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF DELTONA, FLORIDA; APPROVING WORK AUTHORIZATION TO C.W. ROBERTS CONTRACTING, INC. FOR ASPHALTIC CONCRETE SUPPLY AND PLACEMENT, PURSUANT TO COMPETITIVELY BID GOVERNMENT CONTRACT WITH COUNTY OF VOLUSIA ITB 25-B-43JS; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Deltona, Florida (the “City”), as part of the parks improvements project previously approved by the City Commission under Resolution No. 2026-30, identified the need for parking lot improvements at Harris M. Saxon Community Center (the “Project”); and

WHEREAS, supplying and placing asphaltic concrete is essential for road maintenance, public safety, and protecting adjacent roadways and properties; and

WHEREAS, the City’s Purchasing Policy authorizes the procurement of commodities or contractual services by “piggybacking” contracts that are competitively bid and awarded by other governmental agencies or cooperatives using the same terms; and

WHEREAS, the City has previously entered into a piggyback agreement with C.W. Roberts Contracting, Inc. (the “Vendor”) pursuant to the competitive contract award through County of Volusia ITB 25-B-43JS (the “Piggyback”); and

WHEREAS, the Vendor submitted a proposal pursuant to the Piggyback in the amount of one hundred and sixteen thousand and nine hundred and thirty-six dollars and twenty-five cents (\$116,936.25) for milling and resurfacing, which is attached and incorporated as Exhibit “A” (the “Proposal”); and

WHEREAS, the City Commission seeks to approve the Vendor’s Proposal, using the Piggyback Contract through County of Volusia ITB 25-B-43JS, in an amount of one hundred and sixteen thousand and nine hundred and thirty-six dollars and twenty-five cents (\$116,936.25)

WHEREAS, the City Commission further desires to authorize the City Manager or his designee to execute a change order in an amount not to exceed ten percent (10%) of the total cost for the Proposal in the amount of eleven thousand six hundred ninety-three dollars and sixty-three cents (\$11,693.63), so long as any such change order does not exceed the total cost budgeted in the FY 2026 Budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELTONA, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Recitals Adopted. That the above recitals are hereby adopted, confirmed, and incorporated herein.

Section 2. Purchase Approved. That the Proposal, in substantially the form which is attached hereto, is approved, and the City Manager or his designee is authorized to accept the Proposal and execute and implement the Work Authorization, once approved by the City Attorney as to form and legal sufficiency. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute a change order in an amount not to exceed ten percent (10%) of the total cost of the vendors proposal and an amount of eleven thousand six hundred ninety-three dollars and sixty-three cents (\$11,693.63),

Section 3. Implementation. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to take any action which is necessary to implement this Resolution.

Section 4. Effective Date. That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
