Once the bidder has been notified that his bid has been awarded by the City of Deltona, within the above time frame the price proposed as submitted shall constitute the contract price which shall be executed within the time frames established by these documents.

(b) In the event the award is made to this Bidder, the Bidder will enter into a formal written agreement with the City in accordance with the accepted bid, will execute the contract contained within these documents, and if required provide a Public Construction Bond from a Surety in good standing with the Florida Department of State who is licensed to do business in Florida and acceptable to the City. The Public Construction Bond {if applicable} shall be in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the accepted proposal. The Bidder shall, within seven (7) calendar days of the Notice of Award, submit the required Certificates of Insurance. The Bidder further agrees that in the event of the Bidder's default or breach of any of the agreements of this bid, the bid deposit shall be forfeited.
