In progress:

- **FEMA's Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP)** provides funding to state, local, tribal and territorial governments so they can develop hazard mitigation plans and rebuild in a way that reduces, or mitigates, future disaster losses in their communities.
- **Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant (EECBG)** Program is designed to assist states, local governments, and Tribes in implementing strategies to reduce energy use, to reduce fossil fuel emissions, and to improve energy efficiency.
- **Resilient Florida Planning Grant Program** are available to counties, municipalities, water management districts, flood control districts and regional resilience entities. To effectively address the impacts of flooding and sea level rise that the state faces, eligible applicants may receive funding assistance to analyze and plan for vulnerabilities, as well as implement projects for adaptation and mitigation. On 9/15/23, the City submitted a planning grant application to fund the Theresa Basin Watershed Study with a state-mandated Vulnerability Study.
