Utility Deposit, Service Charge and Transfer Fee

There is a minimum monthly base charge for water, sewer, reclaimed (if available) and irrigation, whether the residence or building is occupied or vacant based on services available at that location.

To establish service you must provide a valid driver's license or a valid Florida Identification Card, social security number and one of the following: lease, deed, preliminary or final settlement statement. If a social security number is not provided and no previous credit history with the City then the deposit is the maximum amount allowed.

If the deed or final settlement is provided by the seller of the property, the buyer will be charged the maximum deposit and service charge. If the buyer provides a valid driver's license or a valid Florida Identification Card and social security number this will be used to determine the amount of the deposit for the new owner.

It is the policy of the City to require a deposit for water, irrigation, reclaimed, and sewer service as follows:

Residential Water, Sewer & Reclaimed Deposits

Fee

Deposits are based on credit score as verified by the "On-Line Utility Exchange":

Definitions of green light, yellow light and red light are listed below:

Non-Residential and Multi-Family (Water, Sewer & Reclaimed) Deposits

The deposit for these accounts will be determined by comparable property use typical for that property classification which will be three (3) times average usage.

Additional Deposits

Fee

1. In the event the utility service is disconnected 2 or more times for non-payment or has received 2 or more returned checks within a 12 month period, or insufficient utility credit score, the City will require a deposit(s) that is three times the average monthly bill.

Deposit Payments Residential Accounts

Owner occupied locations may be billed for the deposit(s) and will have 10 days to pay said deposit(s). If the customer does not pay the deposit(s) within the 10 day period, utility services will be subject to disconnection.

Tenant occupied locations are required to pay deposit in full at the time the account is established.

An applicant for city water and sewer services will not be required to make a deposit when the applicant meets one of the following conditions:

- 1) Has an existing account with good credit standing with the City. Discontinuance of service for non-payment on an existing account will be treated as new applicants.
- 2) Any new customer establishing services will have their credit checked with their social security number as verified by the "On-Line Utility Exchange" or any other provider of similar services. The City will perform one credit check for each new account opened. Based on the results, the customer may or may not be required to pay a deposit.

The City will not transfer a deposit from one individual to another individual. Transfers of deposit(s) from one address to another address for the same individual will be made provided the account balance at the active service location is in a current status (outstanding balance is zero).

If a customer transfers his or her deposit to an account within the system, the final bill on the old account, if delinquent, will be transferred to the current account for collection and the current account will then become subject to collections and disconnection procedures. Customers that are continuously delinquent are subject to an update of their deposit requirements.

Deposit Payments Non-Residential and Multi-Family Accounts

The customer is required to pay the full deposit at the time the account is being established. Failure to comply with this requirement will result in discontinuance of service.

Refund of Deposits

The City will credit the deposit to the customer's account when:

- 1) Residential accounts - The customer has had no delinquencies nor been disconnected for non-payment in the previous 36 months;
- 2) Tenant accounts – deposits will be held until the account is closed;
- 3) Commercial accounts – deposits are held until the account is closed. The deposits are refundable only to the customer whose name appears thereon.

Residential and Non-Residential Customer Deposit

Deposits are kept in a non-interest bearing account.

Records of Deposit

The City will keep records to show:

- Name and address of each person on the account
- Social Security / Federal Employer Identification Number
- Drivers License
- Email Account
- Phone Number
- Amount and date of deposit
- Each transaction concerning deposit

The City will issue a receipt of deposit to each applicant from whom a deposit is received.

A record of each unclaimed deposit will be maintained and the City will make a reasonable effort to return the deposit.

*Non-Residential taps are required to be performed by a license underground contractor to be paid for by the commercial developer.

Courtesy Adjustments

Adjustments will be considered and handled based on in accordance with the City's Courtesy Adjustment policy. Adjustments will not be made on closed accounts or those accounts that do not have a minimum of six (6) months of consecutive usage. Adjustment requests submitted for accounts with less than six months of usage will be held until such time that the account has six months of usage outside of the adjusted bill. Customers wishing to submit for an adjustment must do so by submitting the Adjustment Request Form along with all supporting documentation within 30 days of the first bill date in which the customer is requesting the adjustment.

Submission of an adjustment request does not guarantee that an adjustment will be granted. Additionally it does not preclude the customer from paying the billed amount in order to avoid additional service charges or service interruption. Once an adjustment is completed, it will be considered final. Adjustments will not be reversed at a later time.

The City may, upon written request along with supporting documentation, consider one and only one courtesy leak adjustment per 12 month period for customers who experience above average usage due to a leak. Leak adjustments will be limited to no more than two consecutive bills that are effected by the leak.

The City may, upon written request along with supporting documentation, consider one and only one courtesy adjustment for water loss due to theft, vandalism, or an unexplained water loss per 12 month period. Only one bill will be considered.

Staff may waive a late fee and delinquent charge once in a twelve month period if requested by the customer.

Courtesy Pool Fill Adjustments

The City may, upon written request along with supporting documentation, consider one and only one courtesy adjustment per 12 month period for those residents who have both the City's water and wastewater services for the purpose of filling their pool. Customers must meet all requirements as set forth in the Courtesy Adjustment Policy. An adjustment will only be considered for the wastewater portion of the customer's bill.

Administrative Adjustments

The City Manager or his or her designee is authorized to credit a customer's monthly utility account under the following circumstances:

- a. The adjustment is warranted due to a billing error made by the city
- b. The customer inadvertently transposes one or more numbers while making a payment
- c. The customer inadvertently pays the previous month's statement balance resulting a late payment penalty
- d. Unexplained or unintended usage, to include recalculation of consumption at the lowest tier.

Utility Payment Plans

At the discretion of the City a payment plan may be established for accounts that are currently disconnected or have a past due balance greater than three hundred dollars (\$300.00). The monthly payment plan shall be for a period equal to the number of months in arrears but at no time longer than six months and will be in addition to the normal monthly utility bill. There will be no waiver/reduction of the accrued late fees and delinquency charges and an additional administration fee of \$55.00 will be charged for setting up and administering the payment plan. Upon establishment of the payment plan, agreement by the customer and receipt of the first payment then service can be restored. If a customer fails to complete the payment plan in full, the City shall be entitled to take all legal action permissible, including but not limited to, delivering the underlying utility lien to the county court for enforcement and/or forwarding this matter to a collection agency to secure payment. Payment plans are only allowed once in a twelve month rolling period. For tenant accounts, payment plans can not exceed the term of the lease.

Payment of bills, service charges

Bills for the monthly fee for water, wastewater, reclaimed, irrigation water, stormwater, solid waste services shall be payable as of the billing date.

Additional Postage

Any additional postage charges incurred by the city (for International mailing of utility bills, returned mail, etc.) will be billed to the customer account.

Water and Wastewater Capital Charges and Capital Financing Recovery Fees

Water and wastewater capital charges or impact fees are charged to development to "buy-in" to a proportionate share of System capacity and support a policy of "growth paying for growth." Such fees reduce cost burdens on monthly user rates (help to reduce the need for user rate increases). A formal study performed by GovRates, Inc. recommended that the capital charges and capital financing recovery fees be increased to the following amounts per equivalent residential connection:

Automatic User Rate Adjustments to Keep Up With Inflation in Absence of Formal Rate Study Recommendation or Action By City Commission

Automatic rate indexing is very common among utilities in the State of Florida and is looked upon favorably by credit rating agencies. Such indexing helps utilities to keep up with inflation and avoid large future rate increases. Automatic rate indexing of the monthly utility rates has already been adopted by the City Commission, and the following language maintains the existing policy. A January-to-January measurement basis enables the City to know the following fiscal year's inflationary rate adjustments early in the budget process.

In the absence of a formal study recommendation or action by the City Commission, the above monthly user rates shall be automatically increased for inflationary effects on the costs of operations – without a public hearing – effective for bills rendered on or after January 1st of each fiscal year. The percentage increase shall be the percentage increase, if any, in the *Engineering News-Record (ENR)* Construction Cost Index from January of the preceding calendar year to January of the current calendar year. The first increases under these provisions, if any, shall become effective on January 1, 2027 and, if applicable, shall reflect the ENR Construction Cost Index change from January 2025 to January 2026.

PERSONNEL

All charges to any firm, company or individual requiring outside services are to cover the total salary and benefits of the assigned personnel with an administrative fee included. (There is a two hour minimum charge) All charges will be based on the actual salary and benefit burden of the positions requested / required plus a 10% administration fee.

Note: This covers Special Event, Standby Fire, or EMS (Per request of applicant or City Code)

EQUIPMENT COST

Any City owned vehicles, specialty equipment used for emergency events, call-outs and code enforcement actions or any other activities shall be charged based on the most current FEMA Schedule of Equipment Rates along with a ten percent (10%) administration fee and a thirty percent (30%) mobilization/demobilization fee. All request by a firm, company or individual for City personnel or equipment shall pay a 50% deposit of the total cost prior to services provided. Remaining balance must be paid within seven days after completion of personnel and equipment being provided. In no case shall additional personnel or equipment be provided if there is an outstanding balance with the City.

Note: For special events, standby fire, or EMS permitted / authorized by the city within the City limits, the rates charged for personnel include the assigned staff vehicles as determined by the Fire Chief.

FEE REDUCTIONS / MODIFICATIONS

The City Manager or designee may reduce any miscellaneous fee if part of an interlocal agreement, memorandum of understanding between units of government or other agency, individual or company that the City Commission has an agreement or provides services. However, said reduction shall not be less than the costs and expenses incurred by the city plus a 10% administrative fee. Only the City Commission may reduce said fees below the cost and expenses incurred by the City. The City Manager may not reduce fees related to utility rates, except for adjustments noted under the Water / Sewer / Reclaimed Utility Rates section. The City Manager may increase any fee necessary in order to recoup all costs and expenses incurred by the City plus a 10% administrative fee listed within the Fee Schedule. The City Manager may create any new program fees necessary related to The Center and Parks and Recreation programs and implement as part of any future Fee Schedule.

PENNY ROUNDING

Penny rounding, adopted as the U.S. Mint phases out the penny, adjusts cash transaction totals to the nearest nickel (0.05). Utilizing "symmetrical rounding," totals ending in 1, 2, 6, or 7 cents are rounded down, while those ending in 3, 4, 8, or 9 cents are rounded up. This only affects cash payments, not electronic or check transactions.
