

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-45

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF DELTONA, FLORIDA; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO AWARD MULTIPLE PURCHASE ORDERS FOR THE CITY ROADWAYS MILLING/RESURFACING AND PERMANENT PAVEMENT MARKINGS; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the safety, accessibility, and longevity of the City of Deltona, Florida's (the "City") transportation infrastructure are essential for the well-being of residents and the efficient movement of goods and services; and

WHEREAS, regular maintenance, including roadway resurfacing and striping, is critical to ensure that roads remain in good condition, minimize hazards, and comply with safety standards; and

WHEREAS, the City continues working towards addressing the resurfacing needs Citywide based on Pavement Conditions Index of each roadway section; and

WHEREAS, the FY 2026 Budget for road maintenance encompasses multiple facets, including but not limited to milling/resurfacing and permanent markings; and

WHEREAS, the City's Purchasing Policy authorizes the procurement of commodities or contractual services by "piggybacking" contracts that are competitively bid and awarded by other governmental agencies or cooperatives using the same terms; and

WHEREAS, C.W. Roberts Contracting, Inc. ("CRW") submitted a proposal to provide milling/resurfacing for multiple sites based upon a piggyback procurement pursuant to County of Volusia, Florida ITB No. 25-B-43JS at a price not to exceed three million thirty-five thousand five hundred eighty-two dollars and seventy-four cents (\$3,035,582.74), which are attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit "A" (the "CRW Proposal"); and

WHEREAS, Fausnight Strip & Line, Inc. ("Fausnight") submitted a proposal to provide permanent pavement striping and reflective pavement markers based upon a competitive solicitation based upon a piggyback procurement from Seminole County IFB-604562-23/LNF, Roadway Markings, Striping, and Brick Texture Surfacing, at a price

not to exceed sixty-five thousand six hundred thirteen dollars and fifty-five cents (\$65,613.55), which is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit "B" (the "Fausnight Proposal"); and

WHEREAS, the City Commission desires to authorize the City Manager or his designee to award purchase orders to CRW and Fausnight (collectively the "Vendors") for the completion and delivery of goods and services related the city roadway maintenance in accordance with the CRW Proposal and Fausnight Proposal; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission desires to authorize the City Manager to execute change orders to each Proposal from the Vendors in an amount not to exceed ten percent (10%) of the total cost for each Vendor's Proposal.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELTONA, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Recitals Adopted. That each of the above recitals are hereby adopted, confirmed, and incorporated herein.

Section 2. Purchase Approved. That the City Manager or designee is authorized to award purchase orders to the Vendors at a price not to exceed three million thirty-five thousand five hundred eight-two dollars and seventy-four cents (\$3,035,582.74) for CRW and exceed sixty-five thousand six hundred thirteen dollars and fifty-five cents (\$65,613.55) for Fausnight proposal attached herein as Exhibit "A, and " Exhibit "B," and is further authorized to execute change orders in an amount not to exceed ten percent (10%) of the total cost for each Vendor's Proposal.

Section 3. Implementation. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to take any action which is necessary to implement this Resolution.

Section 4. Effective Date. That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
