Contact your fire sprinkler contractor to repair the bent deflector on the sprinkler head under the office stairs, and to clean the loaded heads in the receiving area, as notated on the 2/13/2026 fire sprinkler inspection report.

The property owner is requesting the fine amount be reduced to 5% or \$402.50 due to the financial burden the violation has inflicted as well as contractor and engineering issues. The property reach compliance February 3, 2026.
