

## NOTICE FOR PUBLIC MEETINGS FOR THE AFFORDABLE HOUSING ADVISORY COMMITTEE (AHAC) AND FOR THE CITY COMMISSION REGARDING A STATE-MANDATED AFFORDABLE HOUSING INCENTIVE STRATEGIES REPORT

The City of Deltona is required by Florida Statute 420.9076 to establish an Affordable Housing Advisory Committee (AHAC) in order to complete an Affordable Housing Incentive Strategies Report. The report recommends specific actions or initiatives to encourage or facilitate removing regulatory barriers that limit or increase the costs of development and preservation of affordable housing units within the City.

The recommendations outlined in the report may include modification to or repeal of existing policies, procedures, ordinances, regulations, or plan provisions, the creation of exceptions applicable to affordable housing, or the adoption of new policies, procedures regulations, incentives, ordinances or plan provisions, including recommendations to amend the local government comprehensive plan and corresponding regulations, ordinances and other policies. The City is required, at minimum, to submit the report to the Florida Housing Finance Corporation and annually thereafter evaluate implementation of each approved action.
