

RESOLUTION NO. 2024-68

**A RESOLUTION OF CITY OF DELTONA, FLORIDA;
REQUESTING APPROVAL TO ENTER INTO A
CONTRACT FOR THE PURCHASE OF SEWAGE
REMEDATION SERVICES WITH SAK CONSTRUCTION,
LLC THROUGH A PIGGYBACK CONTRACT WITH
THEIR CONTRACT WITH THE CITY OF PORT ST. LUCIE,
FLORIDA; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS,
SEVERABILITY, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, the City of Deltona, Florida (“City”) is in need of a company to perform sanitary sewer rehabilitation measures within the City; and

WHEREAS, sanitary sewer rehabilitation services include, but are not limited to, improving structural integrity of the sanitary sewer system as well as reducing infiltration and exfiltration into and out of the sanitary sewer system; and

WHEREAS, sanitary sewer rehabilitation services are necessary to reduce the amount of groundwater that leaks into and out of the sanitary sewer system through defects in the aging system, thereby extending the useful life of the pipework currently in place throughout the sanitary sewer system; and

WHEREAS, the City has proposed the allocation of up to one million U.S. Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) via blanket purchase order for the purpose of procuring sewer rehabilitation services; and

WHEREAS, a blanket purchase order is necessary as these services are prioritized based on findings through closed circuit television inspections of the sanitary sewer system and are performed based upon linear square feet that are accomplished throughout the fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the aforementioned funds are budgeted, and

WHEREAS, SAK Construction, LLC (“SAK”), a Florida limited liability company based in Apopka, Florida, has an active contract (Contract #20180197) with the City of Port St. Lucie, Florida to perform sanitary sewer rehabilitation services; and

WHEREAS, the City seeks to piggyback on SAK’s “Contract #20180197” with Port St. Lucie in order to retain SAK to perform sewer rehabilitation services for the City as permitted under Florida Statute Section 189.4221; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE
CITY OF DELTONA, FLORIDA:**

Section 1. **Contract.** The City will enter into a piggyback contract with SAK on the basis of SAK’s Contract# 20180197 with the City of Port St. Lucie, Florida to enter into an agreement with SAK to perform sanitary sewer remediation services.

Section 2. **Terms.** Once fully executed, SAK and the City agree to be bound by the contract with the City of Deltona based on piggyback contract #20180197 with the City of Port St. Lucie. SAK is responsible for the successful completion of their obligations under the piggyback. The contract will expire at midnight on December 31, 2025, unless the parties agree to extend the contract for additional period of time. All prices for this term are outlined in the “Contract Item Description” of the piggyback contract #20180197 with the City of Port St. Lucie, Florida.

Section 3. **Conflicts.** All Resolutions or parts of this Resolution insofar as they are inconsistent or in conflict with the provisions of this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of any conflict.

Section 4. **Severability.** In the event any portion of this Resolution is determined to be invalid, illegal, or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall in no manner affect the remaining portion or sections of the Resolution which shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 5. **Effective Date.** This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
