THIS CAUSE was heard on January 24, 2024, before the undersigned Special Magistrate, after being duly noticed, to determine whether the previously-determined violation was timely corrected. The undersigned Special Magistrate having heard the arguments of the parties and the evidence presented and having reviewed the record and being otherwise fully advised, makes the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law:

Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law

Based upon the evidence and testimony presented at this hearing under oath, the Code Compliance Special Magistrate finds:

- 1. The property which is the subject of this code Compliance action is described as 813006000020 with physical address 1200 Deltona Boulevard, Suite #50, Deltona, FL 32725.
- 2. The Respondent was properly provided a Notice of Hearing (Massey) in accordance with Section 2-112 of the City of Deltona Code of Ordinances ("City Code") and consistent with Sections 162.06 and 162.12 of the Florida Statutes.
- 3. On September 27, 2023, the Special Magistrate found the Respondent in Violation of Chapter 42, Article IV, Fire Codes, Ch. 42-186. Adopted, Florida Fire Prevention Code 7th Edition, NFPA 1, Ch. 1, 1.7.12.5 & NFPA 101 Ch. 14.3.4.1.1, and issued an Order Finding Violation and Requiring Compliance ("Order").

- 4. The Respondent was ordered to correct the violation by 4:00 P.M. on November 30, 2023, which required the Respondent to cease and desist the use of the space as an educational occupancy or obtain a change of occupancy permit and pass all required final inspections. Further, the educational occupancy use required the installation of a fire alarm system in accordance with NFPA 1, Chapter 13, and the 2016 NFPA 72 or to extend the existing fire alarm system to the suite.
- 5. The Captain / Assistant Fire Marshall Samuel Schaller testified that he/she reinspected the property for compliance on January 24, 2024, and testified and presented photographs of the following conditions that remain on the property, which constitute continuing non-compliance with the Order: The space is still be utilized as a charter school occupancy and the fire alarm has not been installed or extended within the suite.
- 6. The Respondent was present and did testify at the hearing. Respondent testified he has engaged with an Engineer and Architect firm, and currently are awaiting final approval of the plans, in order to correct the violations.
- 7. Respondent either failed or refused to correct such violation within the reasonable time provided in the Notice of Violation and remained in violation at the time of the hearing.

BASED ON THE FOREGOING FACTS AND CONCLUSIONS, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

- 1. Respondent failed to correct the violation and comply with Ordinance of the City of Deltona: Chapter 42, Article IV, Fire Codes, Ch. 42-186. Adopted. Florida Fire Prevention Code 7th Edition, NFPA 1, Ch. 1, 1.7.12.5 & NFPA 101 Ch. 14.3.4.1.1., within the time ordered.
- 2. A fine is hereby imposed in the amount of \$2750 as of the hearing date, January 24, 2024, which shall continue to accrue at a rate of \$50 per day and shall continue each and every day until the violation is corrected and full compliance is confirmed by the Captain / Assistant Fire Marshall.
- 3. The Respondent is further ordered to contact the Code Compliance Officer to verify compliance with the Order, on/at the property described as Parcel No.: 813006000020 physical address: 1200 Deltona Boulevard, Suite #50, Deltona, FL 32725.
- 4. Any and all future recurrences of the violation addressed herein after same has been corrected shall necessitate further proceedings before the Code Compliance Special Magistrate without necessarily providing Respondent an opportunity to correct such violation. The Code Compliance Special Magistrate, upon finding such repeat violation exists may impose a fine not to exceed five hundred dollars (\$500.00) per day for each repeat violation, beginning on the first day the repeat violation is found to exist.
- 5. A Certified copy of this Order may be recorded in the Public Records of Volusia County and thereafter shall constitute a lien against the subject property on which the

violation exists and upon any other real or personal property owned by the Respondent. This recorded Order shall constitute notice of the lien to any subsequent purchasers, successors in interest, or assigns of all real and personal property owned by the Respondent, and the findings herein shall be binding upon the Respondent and any subsequent purchasers, successors in interest, or assigns.

6. This Order may be appealed to the Circuit Court within thirty (30) days of its execution.

THIS CAUSE came on for public hearing before the Special Magistrate, on September 27, 2023 after due notice to Respondent to determine whether a violation of the City of Deltona Code of Ordinances exists or existed on the property. The Special Magistrate, having heard the arguments of the parties and the evidence presented and having reviewed the record and being otherwise fully advised, makes the following Findings of Fact and Conditions of Law.

Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law

Based upon the evidence and testimony presented at this hearing under oath, the Code Enforcement Special Magistrate finds:

- 1. The property which is the subject of this action is located at 1200 Deltona Boulevard, Suite #50, Deltona, Florida 32725.
- 2. The Respondent was provided a Notice of Violation and Notice of Hearing in accordance with Section 2-112 of the City of Deltona Code of Ordinances ("City Code") and consistent with Sections 162.06 and 162.12 of the Florida Statutes.

- 3. The Notice of Violation identified a violation of Chapter 42, Article IV, Fire Codes, Ch. 42-186. Adopted. Florida Fire Prevention Code 7 Edition, NFPA 1, Ch. 1, 1.7.12.8 & NFPA 101 Ch. 14.3.4.1.1. which requires a permit prior to any change of occupancy and installation of a fire alarm system for an educational occupancy. The Notice of Violation described the corrective action needed to be taken to remedy the violation. A reasonable time to correct the violation was given by the Code Enforcement Officer in the Notice of Violation until September 19, 2023, as allowed by City Code and Chapter 162, Fla. Statutes.
- 4. The Captain/Assistant Fire Marshall Samuel Schaller testified and submitted photographs into evidence, demonstrating that the building suite is now being used for a charter school occupancy and has no fire alarm system.
- 5. The Respondent was present at the hearing. Respondent testified that he has employees who will begin work on the violations immediately and requested 60 days to come into compliance.
- 6. A violation of Chapter 42, Article IV, Fire Codes, Ch. 42-186. Adopted. the Florida Fire Prevention Code 7 Edition, NFPA 1, Ch. 1, 1.7.12.8 & NFPA 101 Ch. 14.3.4.1.1 exists on the property because a change of occupancy permit, passing of all final inspections, and installation of a fire alarm system have not been obtained as required.
- 7. Respondent either failed or refused to correct such violation within the reasonable time provided in the Notice of Violation and remained in violation at the time of the hearing.

BASED UPON THE FOREGOING FACTS AND CONCLUSIONS, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

- 1. Respondent is given until **4:00 P.M. on November 30, 2023** to correct the violation in the manner provided in the Notice of Violation.
- 2. If the Respondent fails to correct the violation and comply with Section Chapter 42, Article IV, Fire Codes, Ch. 42-186. Adopted. the Florida Fire Prevention Code 7 Edition, NFPA 1, Ch. 1, 1.7.12.8 & NFPA 101 Ch. 14.3.4.1.1, within the time period ordered, a fine of \$50.00 (for both violations combined) will be imposed for each and every day the violation continues past the aforementioned date until the violation is corrected and full compliance is confirmed by the Code Enforcement Officer.




