1. CALL TO ORDER:

The meeting was called to order at 5:30 p.m. by Mayor Avila.

The Mayor and Commission ranked the five applicants received by the deadline and the sheets were handed to the City Clerk for calculating.

The Mayor asked the City Clerk to announce the results of the ranking. The City Clerk stated the rankings are as follows: Kimberly Eddins - 21, Christopher Nabicht - 13, Christian O'Brien - 18, Julio David Sosa - 19, and Jodylee Storozuk - 19. The applicant with the lowest score is Christopher Nabicht with 13.

Motion by Vice Mayor Heriot, seconded by Commissioner Avila-Vazquez, to accept the scoring sheets, the scoring totals, and appoint Chris Nabicht to position six. The motion carried by the following vote:

Against: 1 - Commissioner Colwell
