| ACTIVE MEMBERSHIP

Our Multi-Generational Impact

We serve a robust base of **7,742 Active Members** in the City of Deltona in 2026, establishing deep communal ties.

33% of members are Seniors, bringing **2,546 active members over 60 years old** to customized wellness, social networks, and active living classes.

20% of members are Youth, supporting **1,548 youth under 16 years old** with character development and sports.

-  **1,551 Sports Participants so far in 2026** – Developing character on our Sports programs
-  **Exceeding Projections** – On track to serve **over 2,000 participants** in youth sports by the close of 2026.
-  **300 Swim Lessons** – Delivering vital aquatics education and life-saving drowning prevention to Deltona's children.
-  **2,057 Program Members** – Engaging dynamically in social and development metrics.

Wellness & Programs For All

Economic challenges should never dictate access to our YMCA. So far in 2026, the YMCA has distributed over **\$34,888 in direct Financial Assistance.**

This program has already served over **1,658 local Deltona residents**, ensuring they can access our physical programs and active community resources without strain.



SUMMER CAMP & AFTERSCHOOL

 **Summer Day Camp** – Providing active enrichment for **623 kids** over 10 week summer period, sustaining **60+ children per week** with safe supervision.

 **Afterschool Care** – Nurturing over **1800 children's** over the course of the school year, supporting **40 kids per week** with homework help and athletic play.

 **Community Volunteers** – Powered by a dedicated network of around **180 community volunteers** and coaches giving back to Deltona in 2026.
