


Client Demographics

Average age of residents is 50+

Residents are 40% female, 60% male

Approximately 35% of residents are black, 65% white

Approximately 90% have medical/psychiatric conditions

Average length of stay is 61 days

Medical Concerns

The Average Lifespan of an unhoused person is 57 years

65% - 80% have diagnosed mental illness including PTSD, schizophrenia, depression, bipolar disorder, and schizo-affective disorder

84% have history of drug or alcohol addictions

90% have medical issues including: Chronic disorders such as hypertension, seizure disorders, diabetes, and asthma

Other medical conditions include HIV, cancer, multiple sclerosis, chronic kidney, liver, and heart conditions

1050 residents housed (50%) 93% of those housed at least two years ago are still in housing

697 residents with SSI or SSDI (33%)	
	1294 residents w/income (61%)
1131 residents with Medicare/ Medicaid/other insurance (54%)	1081 residents with food stamps (52%)
166 received birth certificates (8%)	All residents receive access to medical and mental health services

Veterans

Over the last five years, 8% of residents in the First Step Shelter program have been veterans.

We have assisted 175 veterans and 98 (56%) have gone into housing so far.


