

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-58

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELTONA, FLORIDA, RELATING TO THE PROVISION OF STREETLIGHTING SERVICES, FACILITIES AND PROGRAMS IN THE CITY OF DELTONA; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO TRANSMIT THE ESTIMATED ASSESSMENT RATE FOR STREETLIGHTING SERVICES, FACILITIES, AND PROGRAMS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2026, TO THE OFFICE OF THE PROPERTY APPRAISER FOR INCLUSION ON THE TRIM NOTICE; AUTHORIZING A PUBLIC HEARING AND DIRECTING PROVISION OF NOTICE THEREOF; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS, SEVERABILITY, SCRIVENER'S ERRORS, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Commission of Deltona, Florida (the "Commission"), has enacted Ordinances 96-47, 23-2008, and 17-2025, codified in Article IV, "Street Lighting," and Chapter 54, "Special Assessments," which authorizes the annual reimposition and annual indexing of Assessments for Streetlighting Services, Facilities, and Programs, against all Benefitted Property within the City of Deltona; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission of Deltona, Florida, adopted Resolutions Nos. 96-28 (Numerous), 97-12 (Giovanni Street), 97-13 (Acadian Drive), 97-17 (Whipple Drive), 98-23 (Brickell Drive), 98-26 (Diamond Street), 99-43 (Antoinette Street), 99-50 (Waco Drive), 00-02 (Arbor Ridge), 00-15 (Expansion of Waco Drive), 00-20 (Beal Street), 01-03 (Baylor Drive), 01-09 (Saxon Ridge), 01-25 (Anchor Drive), 01-30 (Shafton Avenue), 02-05 (Prescott Blvd.), 02-25 (Embassy Drive), 02-27 (Arbor Ridge to include Unit 2), 02-34 (Saxon Ridge to include Phase 2), 03-32 (Rosetta Drive), 04-34 (Saxon Ridge to include Phase 2B), 04-35 (Saxon Ridge to include Phase 3), 04-43 (Arbor Ridge to include Unit 2, Tract P & Unit 3), 06-10 (Ludlum Drive), 06-49 (Lynn River), 06-56 (Arbor Ridge to include Unit 4), 07-39 (Echo Court), 07-36 (Brewster Drive), 08-14 (Croton Avenue), 08-29 (Maldiva Court), 10-08 (Sullivan Street), 15-11 (Coachman Drive), 15-26 (Oasis Avenue), 15-41 (Arbor Ridge to include Unit 5), and 19-57 (Pinewood) imposing streetlighting assessments in the City of Deltona; and

WHEREAS, the imposition of Streetlighting Assessments each fiscal year is an equitable and efficient method of allocating and apportioning Streetlighting Services, Facilities, and Programs Costs among parcels of Benefitted Property; and

WHEREAS, the Commission desires to reimpose the Streetlighting Assessments within the City using the uniform collection method for the Fiscal Year beginning on October 1, 2026; and

WHEREAS, the City is required to advise the Property Appraiser of its maximum annual assessment, and the date, time and place at which a public hearing will be held to consider the annual assessment rate pursuant to Section 197.3632, Florida Statutes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELTONA, FLORIDA;

Section 1. Authority. This Resolution is adopted pursuant to Section 54-253, Code of Ordinances, City of Deltona, Florida (the "Code"); the Initial Assessment Resolution and the Final Assessment Resolution; Sections 166.021 and 166.041, Florida Statutes; and other applicable provisions of law.

Section 2. Streetlighting Estimated Assessment Rate. It is hereby ascertained, determined, and declared that the estimated assessed cost for the streetlighting services, facilities, and programs for Benefited Parcels for the Fiscal Year beginning October 1, 2026, shall be as set forth in Exhibit "A" (the "Estimated Assessment Rate") attached hereto and incorporated herein.

Section 3. City Manager Authorized. The City Manager or his designee is hereby authorized to transmit the Estimated Assessment Rate to the Office of the Property Appraiser for inclusion on the TRIM Notice

Section 4. Authorization of Public Hearing. There is hereby established a public hearing to be held at 6:30 p.m. on September 9, 2026, or as soon thereafter as may be heard, at the Deltona Commission Chambers, 2345 Providence Blvd., Deltona, Florida at which time the City Commission will receive and consider any comments on the Streetlighting Assessment from the public and affected property owners and adoption of the annual rate resolution for the upcoming fiscal year.

Section 5. Conflicts. All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 6. Severability. If any clause, section, part or application of this resolution is held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, the validity of the remaining portions or applications of this resolution shall not be affected thereby.

Section 7. Scrivener's Errors. Typographical errors and other matters of a similar nature that do not affect the intent of this Resolution, as determined by the City Clerk and City Attorney, may be corrected.

Section 8. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
