A. Fire Stations

The Interim Fire Chief gave a brief presentation which included Station 61, Station 62, Station 63, Station 64, Station 65, Call Volume, NFPA 1710, Strategic Placement, Future Locations of Deltona Fire Stations, Current Performance: 54.07%, Projected Performance: 67.54%, Results of Strategic Placement, Station Realignment, Expansion of Coverage, and Project Summary.

The Mayor opened the public comments and residents addressed the City Commission.

The Commission, City Manager and staff discussed available property, needing equipment and manpower, dispatch and response times, doing things strategically, staffing levels, reducing response times, medical calls, renovating Station 64, Deltona Wild Information Session, call volumes, adjusting the timeline, possible temporary staff, transport units, communications hub and satellite locations, accounting for new

subdivisions and roads, building vertically, training, duplicate calls, removing stations, transport and core stations, Paramedics/EMT, weight times at hospitals, grants, architectural designs, micro-fire stations, increased growth, medical units, ISO rating and insurance rates.
