## **RESOLUTION NO. 2025-159**

A RESOLUTION OF CITY OF DELTONA, FLORIDA; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE THE JOINT PROJECT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF VOLUSIA AND THE CITY OF DELTONA FOR THE SWEET GUM LAKE FLOOF MITIGATION PROJECT THROUGH THE HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT (HUD) COMMUNITY DISASTER BLOCK GRANT-DISASTER RECOVERY (CDBG-DR); PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Volusia County (the "County") has received Community Development Block Grant – Disaster Recovery ("CDBG-DR") funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD") Grant B-23-UN-12-0005 to aide citizens of Volusia County in their recovery from Hurricane Ian; and

**WHEREAS,** the City has a project, the mitigation of flooding through construction of piping and a pump station between two drainage retention areas, and, in conjunction with the County, has determined that the Sweet Gum Lake Flood Mitigation project is eligible and meets all of the requirements of HUD Grant B-23-UN-12-0005; and

WHEREAS, under HUD CDBG-DR Grant B-23-UN-12-0005, the anticipated total project budget is one million eight hundred thirty nine thousand and forty dollars and zero cents (\$1,839,040.00) with a fifty percent (50%) cost share of CDBG-DR Funds in the amount of nine hundred nineteen thousand five hundred and twenty dollars and zero cents (\$919,520.00) and nine hundred nineteen thousand five hundred and twenty dollars and zero cents (\$919,520.00) to be matched by the City of Deltona (the "City"); and

WHEREAS, the City recognizes the benefits of receiving a permanent stormwater pump station and infrastructure at Sweet Gum Lake to promote flood risk reduction, environmental resilience, and public benefit consistent with the intent of the Transform386 Programs; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds it to be in the best interest of the City to enter into the Joint Project Agreement with the County for the Sweet Gum Lake Flood Mitigation Project under the Transform386 Programs (the "JPA"); and

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**WHEREAS**, the City Commission desires to authorize the City Manager or his designee to execute the JPA.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELTONA, FLORIDA:

**Section 1. Recitals Adopted.** That each of the above recitals is hereby adopted, confirmed, and incorporated herein.

**Section 2. City Manager Authorized.** That the City Commission hereby authorizes the City Manager or his designee to execute the JPA, subject to any changes as may be required by the HUD.

**Section 3. Implementation.** That the City Manager or his designee is hereby authorized to take any action which is necessary to implement this Resolution.

**Section 4. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
