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Venous Leg Ulcer: Treatment

- Compression Therapy
 - Multilayer
 - short stretch
- Debridement/ dressing application
- Medications (pentoxifylline / Doxycycline)
- Wound Closure
 - Autologous skin graft
 - Cellular products (Apligraf/ Theraskin/ placental products)
- Endo-venous closure (laser ablation)







Diabetic Foot Ulcer



- Foot Deformity
- Neuropathy
 - Sensory
 - Autonomic

- Micro/ macro vascular disease
- Immune impairment
- Glycemic dysregulation



Diabetic Foot Ulcer: Treatment

Off-loading

"Its about *MECHANICS, not MEDICINE*... it's more important what you *TAKE OFF* the wound than what you *PUT ON*"

- Debridement / dressing selection (clean, moist wound bed)
- Evaluate and correct ischemia /infection
- Optimizing medical management (glycemic control)
- Adjunctive therapy
 - Cellular- based products (i.e., Theraskin, placental tissue
 - HBOT



Pressure Ulcer

- Pressure avoidance
 - Frequent repositioning
 - Pressure reducing surface
- Nutrition: ensure proper intake and monitor
- Continence and moisture control
- Wound care
 - Debridement
 - Dressing selection
 - Infection surveillance / control
 - Advanced modalities
 - NPWT
 - Dermal matrices
 - HBOT
 - Surgical flap
