RESOLUTION NO. 2020-64 (Supersedes No. 2019-46)

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELTONA, FLORIDA, **PROVIDING ADJUSTMENTS** TO THE WASTEWATER AND RECLAIMED WATER **BASE CHARGES: PROVIDING** FOR ANNUAL RATE INDEXING OF WASTEWATER AND RECLAIMED WATER BASE FACILITY CHARGE AND USAGE RATES; **PROVIDING** FOR THE ELIMINATION OF USAGE OF Α CAP 10,000 GALLONS **FOR** WASTEWATER **CHARGES**; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY: AND **PROVIDING** AN EFFECTIVE DATE. **FOR**

WHEREAS, Section 68-52 of the City Code of Ordinances outlines the City goal of maintaining a fiscally responsible rate schedule in order to maintain the utility systems, meet our Bond and Debt Obligations and to allow for future growth; and

WHEREAS, Section 68-64 of the City Code of Ordinances allows for annual indexing of Utility Rates; and

WHEREAS, Section 68-64 of the City Code of Ordinances mandates that rate increases for Water and Wastewater must be by separate Resolutions; and

WHERAS, The City of Deltona retained the consulting firm of GovRates, Inc. to complete a comprehensive Rate Study for City of Deltona Water and Wastewater (Deltona Water). GovRates recommended the City of Deltona adjust the Wastewater and Reclaimed Water Base Rates; eliminate the 10,000 cap on Wastewater usage charges; provide for annual indexing based on the *Engineering News Record* (ENR) Construction Cost Index of Wastewater and Reclaimed Water rates beyond 2014; and adjust the combined Impact Fee and Capital Fund Recovery Fee. These adjustments are required to keep the budget for Deltona Water solvent through 2023 and beyond while maintaining the existing system; completing projects needed to maintain the system; and to meet obligations outlined in the 2020 Consumptive Use Permit (CUP) from the St. Johns River Water Management District (SJRWMD); and

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WHEREAS, the City Commission conducted a Workshop on 28 September 2020 that included a comprehensive review of the Water and Wastewater Funds in the GovRates, Inc., Rate Study; and

WHEREAS, the proposed rates are considered affordable by utility industry standards; and

WHEREAS, the City has provided notification of the December 14, 2020, public hearing in customer utility bills as required by Section 180.136, Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the City will provide notifications in Water & Utility bills to inform ratepayers of the proposed adjustments beginning 1 April 2021 as required by Section 180.136, Florida Statutes.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELTONA, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1: The Wastewater and Reclaimed Water Base Facility Charge and Usage/Volumetric Charges shall be increased by the following percentages for the Fiscal Years 2022 through 2024 consistent with previously adopted percentages:

Fiscal Year	Effective Date	Wastewater and Reclaimed Water Rate Adjustments
2022	October 1, 2021	5.0%
2023	October 1, 2022	5.0%
2024	October 1, 2023	5.0%

The adjustments shall be effective for all bills rendered on or after the effective date for each Fiscal Year.

Commencing in Fiscal Year 2025, and in the absence of a formal study recommendation or action by the city commission, the Wastewater and Reclaimed Water Base Facility Charges and Usage / Volumetric Charges shall be automatically increased for inflationary effects on the costs of operations – without a public hearing –

effective for bills rendered on or after October 1st of each fiscal year. The percentage increase shall be the percentage increase, if any, in the *Engineering News-Record* Construction Cost Index from January of the preceding calendar year to January of the current calendar year. The first increases under these provisions, if any, shall become effective on October 1, 2024.

Section 2: The Wastewater Base Facility Charges and Usage / Volumetric Charges for inside-City service shall be adjusted as follows:

Section 4: The rates for customers located outside the City of Deltona shall continue to be 25% higher than inside-City rates as allowed per Florida Statute 180.191.

Section 5: As shown in the tables in Section 2, the proposed base facility charges for residential wastewater service only will include the first 2,000 gallons based on metered water usage.

Section 6: **Conflicts.** All Resolutions or parts of Resolution insofar as they are inconsistent or in conflict with the provisions of this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of any conflict.

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Section 7: Severability. In the event any portion of this Resolution is determined to be invalid, illegal, or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall in no manner affect the remaining portion or sections of the Resolution which shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 8: EFFECTIVE DATE: This Resolution shall take effect for all bills rendered on or after April 1, 2021.
