

RESOLUTION NO. 2021-33

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELTONA, FLORIDA, ADOPTING A PROPOSED MILLAGE RATE FOR THE 2021-2022 FISCAL YEAR; DETERMINING THE ROLLED-BACK RATE; ESTABLISHING A DATE, TIME AND PLACE AT WHICH A PUBLIC HEARING WILL BE HELD TO CONSIDER THE PROPOSED MILLAGE RATE AND THE TENTATIVE BUDGET FOR THE 2021-2022 FISCAL YEAR; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Volusia County Property Appraiser has certified to the City the taxable value of all property within the City for the 2021-2022 fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, it is the responsibility of the City to advise the Property Appraiser of its proposed millage rate, of its rolled-back rate, and the date, time and place at which a public hearing will be held to consider the proposed millage rate and the tentative budget;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELTONA, FLORIDA:

Section 1. A proposed millage rate of 7.85 mills is hereby adopted for the 2021-2022 fiscal year.

Section 2. The rolled-back rate for the 2021-2022 fiscal year is _____ mills.

Section 3. A public hearing will be held on September 9, 2021 at 6:30 p.m., or as soon thereafter as may be heard, at Deltona City Hall, 2345 Providence Boulevard, Deltona, Florida, to consider the proposed millage rate and the tentative budget.

Section 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its final adoption by the City Commission.
