

RESOLUTION NO. 2021-48

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELTONA, FLORIDA, ADOPTING A TENTATIVE MILLAGE RATE FOR THE 2021-2022 FISCAL YEAR; COMPARING TENTATIVE MILLAGE RATE WITH THE ROLLED-BACK RATE; ESTABLISHING A DATE, TIME, AND PLACE AT WHICH A PUBLIC HEARING WILL BE HELD TO ADOPT A FINAL MILLAGE RATE; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on July 6, 2021, the City Commission adopted a proposed millage rate, computed a rolled-back rate, and established a date, time, and place for a public hearing to consider the proposed millage rate and the tentative budget for the 2021-2022 fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the Acting City Manager has delivered a recommended budget for the 2021-2022 fiscal year; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELTONA, FLORIDA:

Section 1. A tentative millage rate of 7.8500 mills is hereby adopted for the 2021-2022 fiscal year.

Section 2. The tentative millage rate of 7.8500 mills is 9.31 percent more than the rolled-back rate of 7.1812 and represents a 9.31 percent increase in property taxes.

Section 3. A public hearing will be held on September 20, 2021 at 6:30 p.m., or as soon thereafter as may be heard, at Deltona City Hall, 2345 Providence Boulevard, Deltona, Florida, to adopt a final millage rate.

Section 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its final adoption by the City Commission.
