Strategic Goal: Transportation Improvements

LOCATION:

West Elkcarn Boulevard

BACKGROUND:

The City of Deltona has aggressively pursued State and Federally funds for local transportation project through the LAP program administered by the State of Florida. Recently, staff completed the Tivoli Sidewalk Project, and we are currently under construction of numerous sidewalks as part of the Sidewalks to Schools initiative.

Moving forward, we are now certified by the FDOT to begin the paved shoulder widening of Elkcarn Boulevard from Sylvia Drive to Fort Smith Boulevard. This \$1,322,087 project will consist of \$1,000,988 (75.7%) State & Federal Funds and \$322,099 (24.3%) local funds. City funds are available for this project in the Transportation Fund.
