Any (non Rush International) quote written before September 30th can still be processed for 60-90 days after September 30th but any new quotes after September 30th would need to be run through HGACBuy.

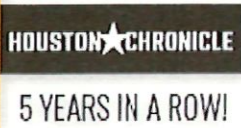
