# COMPSTAT



- **COMPSTAT** is a performance management system that is used to reduce crime and achieve other departmental goals. **COMPSTAT** emphasizes information-sharing, responsibility, accountability, and improving effectiveness.

# COMPSTAT



- **COMPSTAT** involves weekly, crime control strategy meetings as a means to increase the flow of information between all members of the agency, other criminal justice agencies and the community with particular emphasis on the flow of crime and quality of law enforcement information.

# *COMPSTAT Components:*



- **COMPSTAT includes four core components:**
  - Timely and accurate intelligence
  - Rapid deployment of resources
  - Effective tactics
  - Relentless follow-up

# *COMPSTAT Principle*



- The *COMPSTAT* crime control model has continued to be proven effective in Deltona with a Part 1 crimes clearance rate of 60% in 2022 and 69% in 2023.
- The clearance rate for all Group A crimes for 2023 is 79.34%. As a comparison, the national part one crime clearance rate is 31.6%.

9 related cases were cleared with LPR Technology

In May of 2023, a string of auto thefts, vehicle burglaries, and dispensary burglaries began to plague central Florida, to include the city of Deltona. During these incidents, suspects used masks, gloves, and other clothing items to conceal their identity. However, with the use of LPR's vehicle tags were identified and suspects were able to be identified. Arrests were made and all cases were cleared.

The suspects were gang members out of Orange County. With our help, other agencies were also able to charge these suspects for the crimes they committed in their Area of Responsibility.
