

 - Immediate family and caregivers following the death of a loved one on our Halifax Health – Hospice program.
 - Services available for up to 13 months following the death
 - Celebration of Life event









- Children ages 4 18 who have experienced a death, regardless of hospice or traumatic loss connection
- The program encompasses physical activity, art, drama, music, and more.






